

**OFF LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **Fiordland Helicopters Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on or from the premises situated at 7 The Lane, Te Anau, and known as "**Fiordland Cinema and Black Dog Bar**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample for consumption on the premise. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No liquor shall be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on ANZAC Day.
- (b) Liquor may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 10.00 am to 11.00 pm.**
- (c) Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as a **Supervised area**:  
The area surrounding the bar.
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) Serving staff are trained to identify intoxication, and proactively dealing with potentially intoxicated persons.
  - (ii) Appropriate signs detailing the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons must be displayed at every point of sale.
- (e) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers at the same location as alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (f) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- (g) The licensee when making mail order, phone or internet sales must ensure that all the requirements under Section 59 of the Act relating to remote sales are complied with.

**LICENSED PREMISES**


The premises is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped by the Southland District Council on 20 September 2017. The entrance from The Lane is designated as the principal entrance.

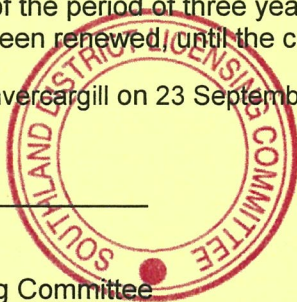
**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) either –
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed until the close of the period of 12 months after that day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
  - (i) until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed until the close of the period of four years after the day it was issued.
